- **Welcome/Intros**
- **Board Update** – Jani Koester
 - Last month, the HSC Board: approved the review tool to monitor CoC projects, approved Written Standards, started the discussion regarding HSC membership/applications
- **Care Wisconsin** – Marjorie Blaschko, Stephanie McCutchin [PowerPoint attached]
 - HMO program for individuals on SSI (many individuals experiencing homelessness)
 - About 50% of health outcomes are due to social factors
 - 2011 NIH study found that 1/3 of patient deaths could be directly attributed to social determinants – represents an opportunity for healthcare stakeholders
 - Care Wisconsin is invested in care coordination (routine wellness initiatives, crisis intervention, invested in wellbeing of members)
 - Payment is coordination of benefits between County, private, and healthcare
- **Portals** – Lewis Lee, Jennifer Pease [handout attached]
 - Amani neighborhood in Milwaukee (53206) is most incarcerated zip code in the country
 - Portal is a gold shipping container that is fitted with immersive audio/visual technology
 - Check it out at: <https://www.sharedstudios.com/portals>
 - Kids in low-income areas have fewer opportunities to see the world outside of their neighborhood, learn about other cultures
 - Mission is to start a global community, currently in 40 places around the world
 - Lewis did research w/ Yale University on putting portals in the most incarcerated areas
 - Did forums on gun violence through the portals, taught foreign languages
 - Different levels of portals: shipping container, inflatable, busses, build one in your room
 - Hope would be to get this technology to Madison, especially University of Wisconsin
- **Keys to Dignity** – Andie Hopkins, Beth Maglio [PowerPoint attached]
 - Friends of State Street Family (FSSF) has been around since 2011, 100% volunteer-based
 - Obvious need for individual storage for folks experiencing homelessness
 - Would like to put lockers around the city in different locations (provider sites)
 - Lockers are managed and monitored by FSSF to ensure safety, cleanliness; painted in urban camouflage to blend in and reduce the risk of judgment or theft
 - Referrals come from case workers, participants must sign an agreement
 - Dane County-funded, FSSF will ensure lockers are built at your agency at no cost to you
 - Goal is to have 100 lockers in downtown locations w/ 24-hour access
