Purpose: A two-phase program to help those with barriers to employment gain

the necessary skills to improve their employability, especially in

food service.

What Is It?: Delta Session is a 4-week job work readiness course. Culinary

Creations is a 8-12 week paid on-the-job training in a commercial

kitchen.

Who Is Eligible?: Anyone is eligible who is currently unemployed and is

experiencing difficulty in finding a job due to certain barriers, but is willing and motivated to put in the time and energy to improve their

job skills. Barriers may include, among others: previous

incarceration, mild disability, lack of education or training, and lack of English language skills. Eligible applicants must free of alcohol

and other drug abuse or be in active recovery.

Expectations: Participants will be expected to fully attend all scheduled Delta

Sessions and complete activities outside of class time as steps toward higher employment. Respect, honesty, and curiosity will allow individuals to move forward through the trainings. Individuals who wish to apply for a position in the Culinary Creations Catering kitchen will interview, complete ServSafe Food Handler course and

employment paperwork.

Benefits: Delta Session participants will have guided practice improving their

soft skills, coaching in preparing resumes and interviews, computer basics, personal finance, basic health, and some case management for basic needs. Culinary Creations participants will be paid \$9.00/hour for kitchen time. Graduates of the program will receive

job placement assistance.
