

### 2002 Zeier Road – Existing Site Aerial






### 2002 Zeier Rd – Floor Plan Concept

✓ Purchased October 2021 by City for Land Banking.


✓ Site search continued with feedback from Finance Committee.

Q1 2025 - TENTATIVE SHELTER MOVE FROM 2002 ZEIER RD. TO 1902 BARTILLON DR.




