- Shared kitchen and bathrooms
- Monthly rent ranges from \$265 - \$450 depending on unit
- Units include a bed and a desk
- Due to high demand, applicants must activate their application by phone five business days after submission, and then continue to call once a month to remain on the waitlist (see intake form for details)

- 20 double occupancy sober transitional housing units
- Applicants must have a mental health diagnosis or a concern with substance abuse
- Applicants must previously have had a lease in Dane County
- Monthly rent is \$650 and includes three meals daily, a snack, and the cost of laundry
- Shared bathrooms
- Residents are expected to apply for jobs and housing weekly
- Residents are required to meet with a human services assistant once a week, at minimum
- Residents must follow a curfew
- All residents' medications are monitored

- Single and double occupancy transitional housing for men only
- Shared bathrooms
- 32 beds total
- Monthly program fees are between \$400 - \$500 and include three meals daily and the cost of laundry
- Residents are expected to participate with program staff
- Sober environment

4006 NAKOOSA TRAIL, MADISON, WI 53714  PORCHLIGHT, INC.

- 14 single-room occupancy permanent housing units with shared bathrooms
- Applicants must have a mental health diagnosis and be experiencing homelessness (shelter, streets, or car)
- Monthly rent is \$400 and includes three meals daily and the cost of laundry
- Applicants do not need income to apply, however if/when housing is offered, applicants must then have a monthly income of at least \$800
- Waitlist times vary
- Residents may have visitors between 8:30am-6pm
- No visitors under the age of 18 are allowed

HOW TO APPLY

Applications must be completed in person at Safe Haven between 8:30am-6pm

- 24 furnished, single-room occupancy apartments for male military veterans
- Eligibility is determined by Madison Veterans Administration; honorable discharge only
- Applicants must be experiencing homelessness or be at risk of experiencing homelessness
- Shared bathrooms
- Three meals a day are provided
- No income required
- Residents with income pay no more than 30% of their income for rent
- Sober environment

Completed intake forms may be faxed or submitted in person

Applicants are directed to include a copy of their DD-214 and a VA release of information along with their intake form

- Monthly rent ranges from \$500 - \$550 depending on the unit
- Houses are separated by gender

- \$200 - \$250 sober deposit required at move-in
- Houses are separated by gender

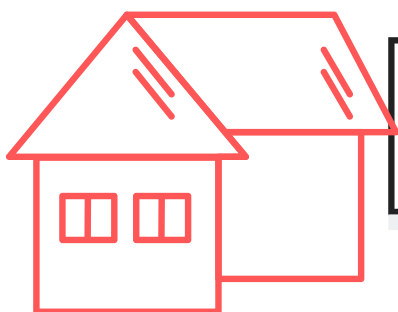
